




Heidsieck & Co. Monopole Champagne, 1907 harvest for Nicholas II

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Mr. Peter Lindberg and offers for sale 3 (remaining from 2,400) bottles of champagne salvaged from sunken in 1916 vessel "Jonkoping", which was found by Peter in 1997.



The condition and quality of the bottles and champagne are
'FINE'





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10 of these bottles were sold for \$275,000 (each!!!) at the auction held in RitzCarlton Hotel in Moscow in 2012.

About champagne...



Heidsieck & Co. Monopole Champagne, 1907 harvest, France

This is the most expensive champagne in the world. It was intended to be delivered to the Russian Emperor - Nicholas II.

However, he was never been able to taste the noble French beverage. This is because in 1917, during the transportation, the vessel with the champagne on board met with the German U-22 submarine. The U-boat sunk the vessel cause it was loaded with, treated as military, cargo.



In 1996, a group of scuba divers led by Peter Lindberg located the sunken vessel with champagne in bottles and cognac in tabs at the bottom of the Gulf of Finland.


In 1997, 550 bottles were salvaged and sold. The sunken schooner "Jonkoping" been salvaged completely to the surface in 1998 with the rest of the cargo.
